For 30 years the Princeton Club of Chicago has served our community as an important pillar of our mission statement. Funded by Chicagoland area alumni and parents, these efforts have included:

- 1) Extensive involvement at CPS Roosevelt HS including tutoring, career day organization, and a competitive college scholarship awarded to "top of the class" graduating seniors. Most recipients are the first in their family to attend college and are mentored by Princeton alumni. Presented since 2010, we have awarded nearly \$145K to 46 deserving students. One of our first scholars has now graduated from medical school!
- 2) **Annual support to AlumniCorps** (formerly known as Princeton Project '55). AlumniCorps fellows are recent Princeton graduates who serve in 1-2 year long fellowships with local Chicagoland area non-profits.
- 3) **Annual support to Princeton Internships in Civic Service** to help Chicago area non-profits host paid summer internship experiences for current Princeton students.

While the Club has had sufficient funds for the last few years and therefore has not actively solicited new donations, we now need to restock those funds.
